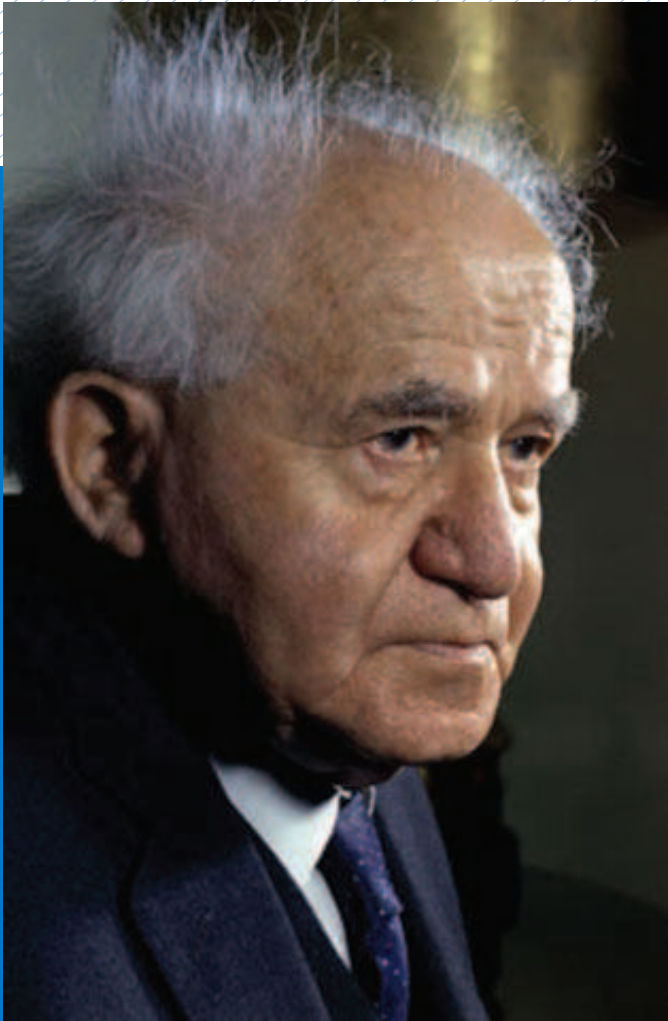

Plus:

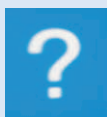
- Students initiate social projects guided by mentor.
