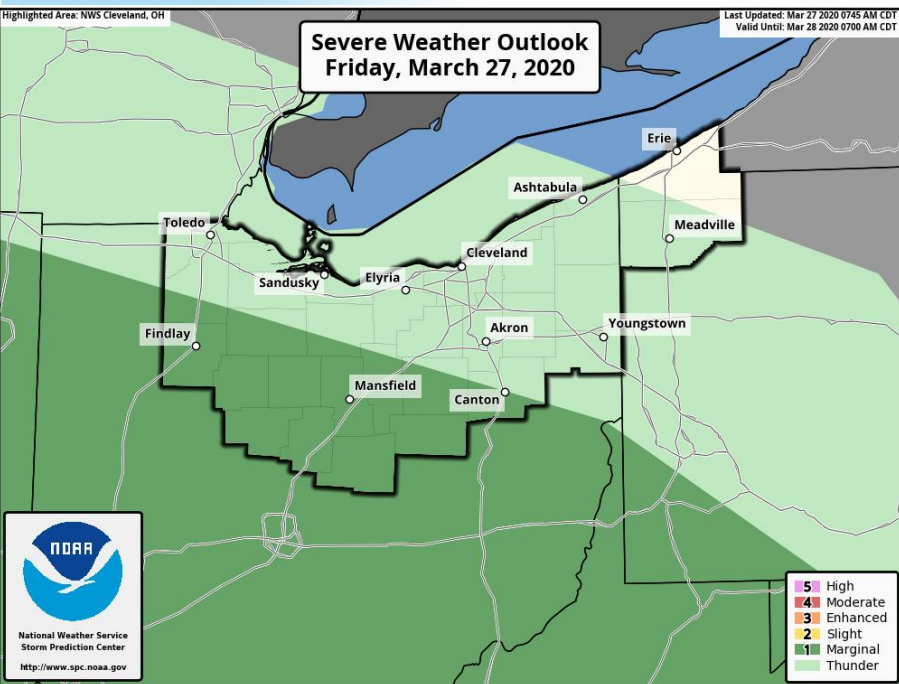




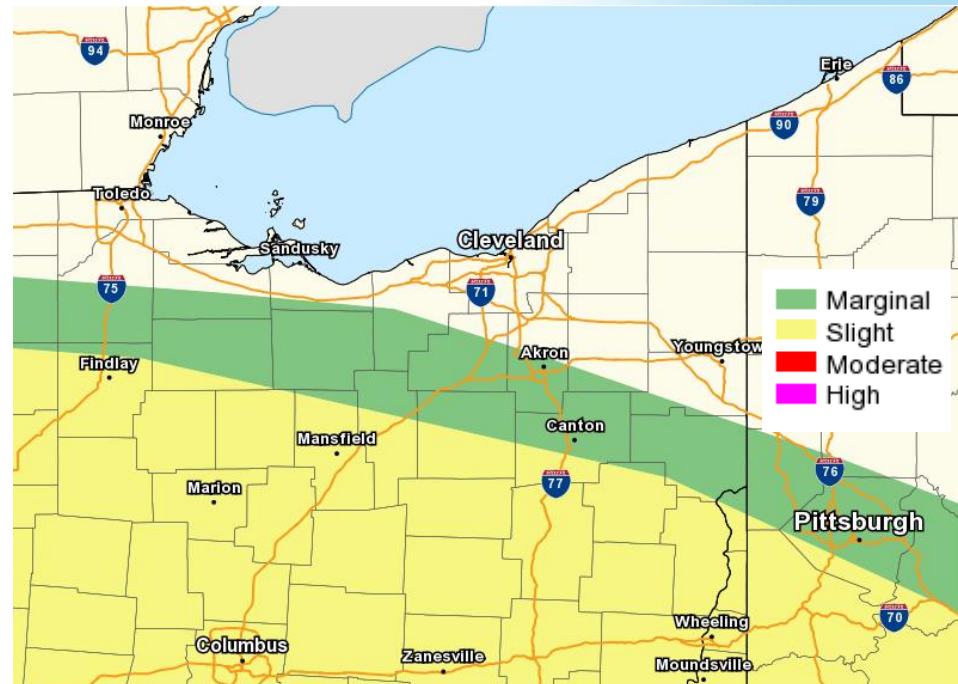
Strong Storms & Heavy Rain Tonight

What to Expect: Strong storms possible overnight. Main threat hail and heavy rain.

Day 1 WPC Excessive Rainfall Outlook



What to Expect: A line of thunderstorms with imbedded heavy rain with an enhanced flood risk.

What to Expect:

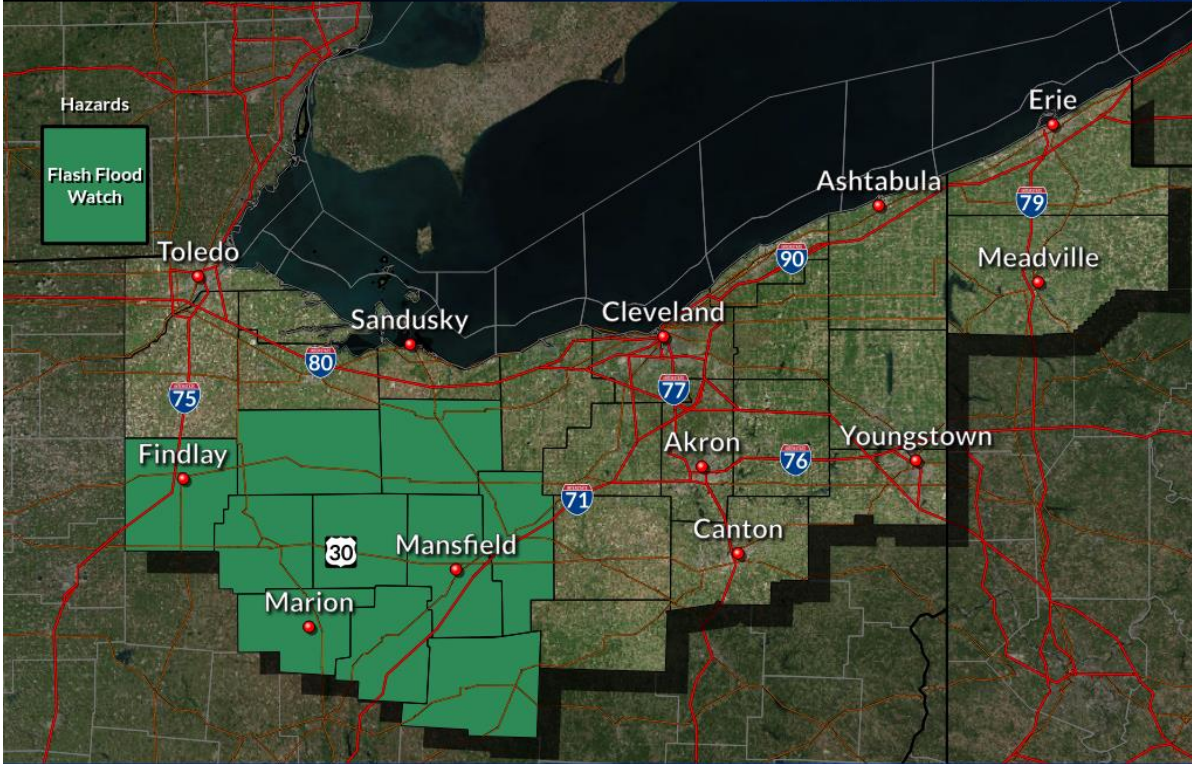
- A stalled line of storms with heavy rain will set up overnight near the U.S. 30 corridor west of I-71
- Areas could see heavy rainfall of over 3 inches which will lead to flash flooding

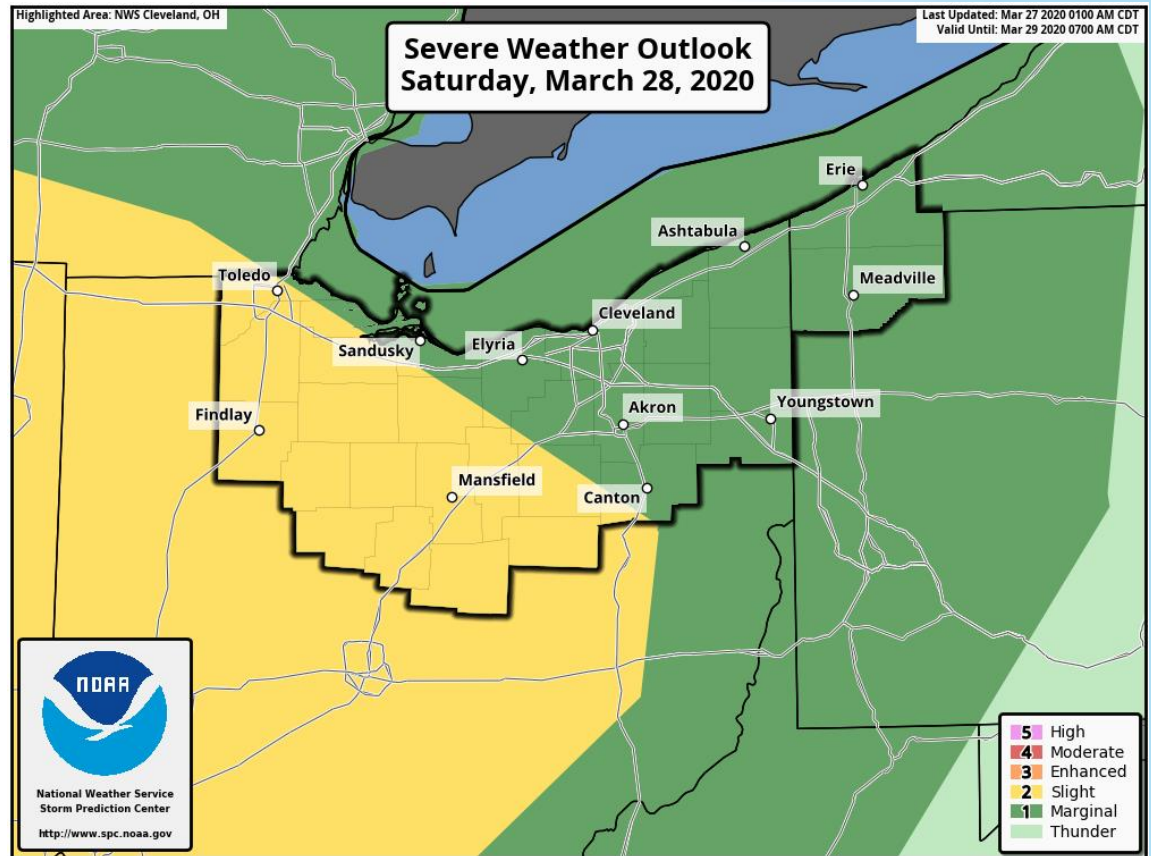
Severe Storms Saturday

- Localized heavy rainfall and isolated flash flooding may also be possible Saturday and Saturday night.

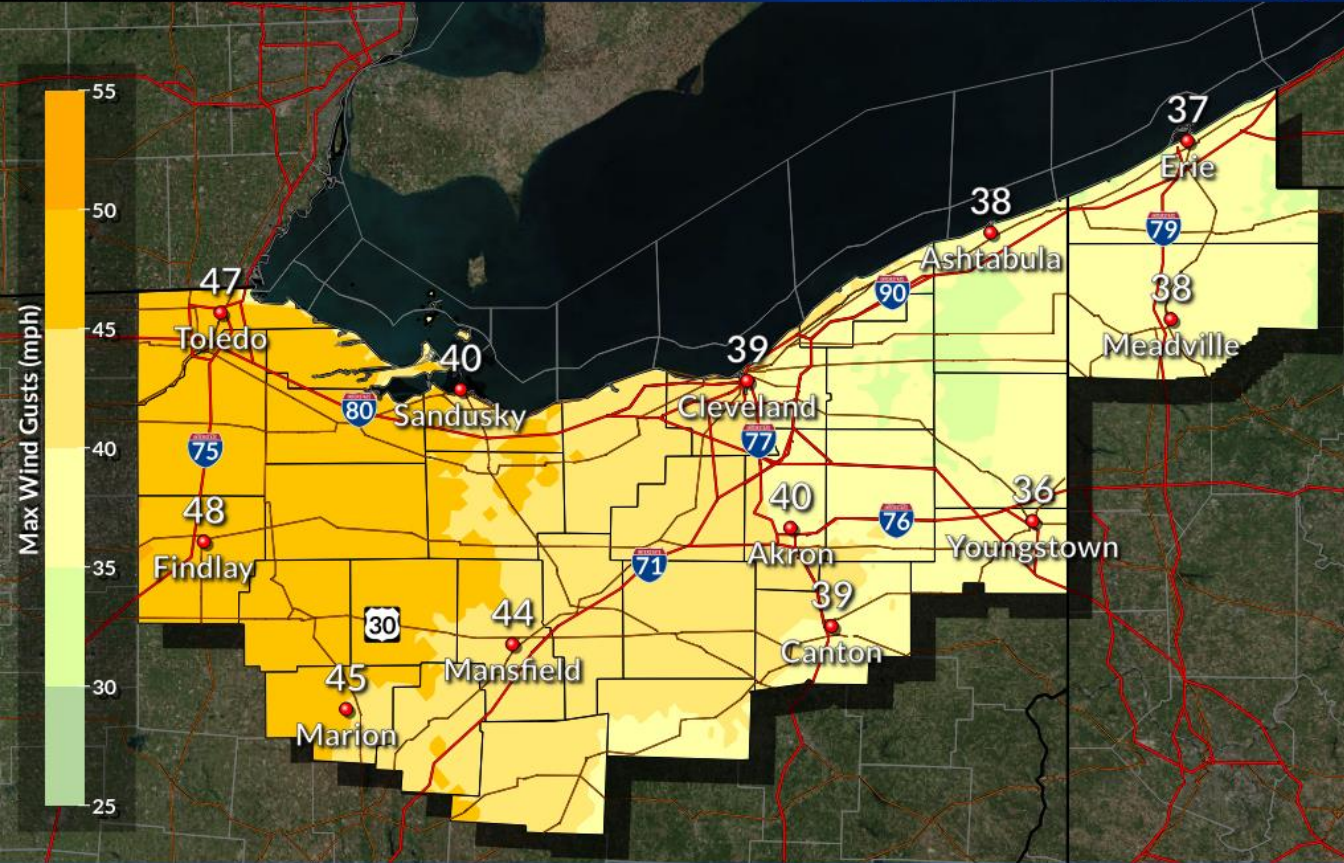


Gusty Winds Sunday
