

# Heavy Rain Expected

## OVERVIEW:

- Rainfall from the remnants of Tropical Storm Nicole will move through the area on Friday.
- The heaviest rain of 2-3" is expected along and east of Interstate 71.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Rain will arrive between 5-9 AM Friday and continue through Friday evening.</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Due to recent dry conditions, area waterways are running at low capacity. This rainfall will result in rises on most rivers, streams, and creeks, but widespread river flooding is not expected.</li> <li>▪ Fall leaves and debris blocking drains could contribute to minor flooding problems.</li> <li>▪ Ponding of water on roads and minor flooding of urban areas possible.</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ None at this time. Stay tuned for possible Watches, Warnings, or Advisories.</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A small swath of heavy rain in excess of 3" is possible. The location of this is hard to pin down but could result in a higher flood threat.</li> </ul>
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b><i>Urge people to clear leaves and fall debris from drains today!</i></b></li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Much colder air will arrive behind this system for the weekend. Minor snow accumulations of 1-3" possible in the snowbelt.</li> </ul>
