End of the 19th century

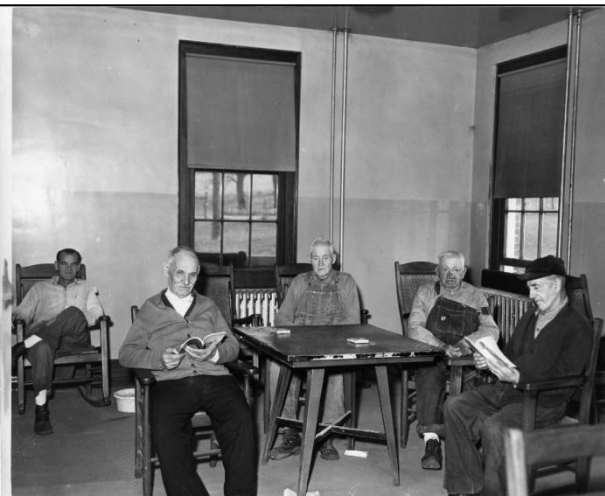


2nd Infirmary
destroyed by fire in 1924





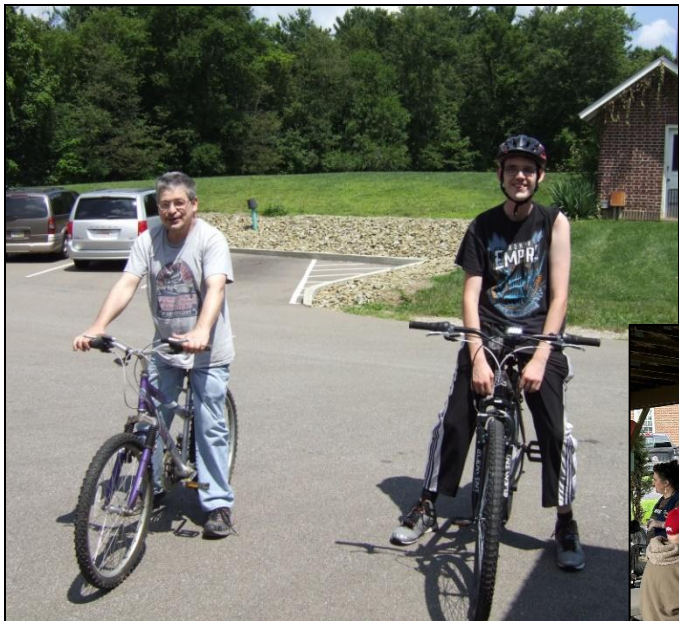
