REINSTATEMENT FEE AMNESTY INITIATIVE

The Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles implemented a driver's license reinstatement fee debt reduction and waiver program for offenders whose driver's licenses have been suspended for specific violations. The program only applies to a driver's license or permit suspension; it does not apply to a commercial driver's license or permit suspension.

The initial program ended on July 31, 2019. Effective October 17, 2019, the program will resume and applications will be accepted and processed through December 31, 2019.

Eligibility for:

Reduction of Fees

1. Completed all eligible court-ordered sanctions except payment of reinstatement fees
2. At least 18 months have expired since the end period of the suspension

Waiver of Fees

1. Completed all eligible court-ordered sanctions except payment of reinstatement fees
2. Proof of indigence by providing a screen shot of your SNAP case status information from Job and Family Services.

How to Apply:

The application period will resume on October 17, 2019. Applications must be received or postmarked by December 31, 2019, to be eligible for the reinstatement fee amnesty initiative.

If you have previously applied for Amnesty Program with the state of Ohio, you are not eligible to apply again.

Starting October 17, 2019, applicants may apply for a reinstatement fee debt reduction or waiver:

*Through BMV Online Services.

Applications for fee "reduction only" can be completed online.

Applications for complete "waiver" of fees must be processed by mail, and must include proof of SNAP.

*Application for fee reduction can be completed in person at a deputy registrar license agency. PLEASE NOTE: If applying for a waiver (amnesty) of fees, the application and supporting documents (proof of SNAP) will need to be mailed to the Columbus office for review and processing.

Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) 4510.10

This is an application for the reduction or waiver of reinstatement fees through the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV). The applicant must meet eligibility requirements listed below, which is outlined in R.C. 4510.10 and processed through the BMV. The application must be completed and filed with the BMV. Applicant will receive notification by mail of approval or denial.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED OR POSTMARKED BY JULY 31, 2019, TO BE ELIGIBLE THROUGH THE REINSTATEMENT FEE AMNESTY INITIATIVE.

Mark the box to apply for:

REDUCTION OF FEES

1. Must have completed all court-ordered sanctions related to the eligible offense other than the payment of reinstatement fees.
2. At least 18 months have expired since the end of the period of the suspension ordered by the court.

WAIVER OF FEES (with proof of case screen shot of SNAP benefits from Job and Family Services)

1. Must have completed all court-ordered sanctions related to the eligible offense other than the payment of reinstatement fees.
2. Must provide proof of indigence by providing a screen shot of your SNAP case status from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, Benefits Self-Service Portal.
