

ORDINANCE NO. 24 – 14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN OFFICIAL TEMPORARILY ACTING IN A CAPACITY OTHER THAN HIS OR HER ORIGINAL CAPACITY TO RECEIVE THE PAY OF THAT POSITION WHILE TEMPORARILY ACTING IN THAT POSITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, from time to time officials cover other elected positions in the City due to a vacancy in that position whether due to resignation, sickness, death, etc., and

WHEREAS, it is Council's position that if that official is acting in a temporary capacity to cover a vacancy in another position then that official should receive the compensation while serving in that role.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ONTARIO, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT while a City Official is covering another elected position, that individual should receive the rate of pay for the position that the official is covering during the time that official is covering for that position. However, under no circumstances shall that official receive the compensation from both the official's original elected position and the position for which that individual is temporarily acting.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for the additional reason to compensate the accordingly while the individual is temporarily filling a vacancy so that the City's operations are minimally affected and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
