

KEY FACTS

The EHOVE Board has placed a 2.2 mill bond issue on the November 5 ballot for the public's consideration. If passed:



Homeowners would experience a tax increase of

\$6.42 per month
per \$100,000 of home valuation



Funding collected from the bond issue would be used to implement the

Facilities Improvement Plan

which was developed by EHOVE's Facilities Planning Committee, consisting of community members and staff from our 800+ square mile district throughout Erie, Huron and Ottawa Counties

Components of the Facilities Improvement Plan include:



Additions, renovations, furnishings, and equipment for EHOVE facilities to meet 21st-century job demands.



Laboratory classroom space for additional educational programming. Options being considered include Dental, Vet Tech and Heavy Machinery.



Addressing campus infrastructure needs, including updating original construction, electrical, water, and sewer systems that date back to the 1960s which are more expensive to repair than rebuild.



Increased security through facility design.



Increased community and business access to the EHOVE campus.

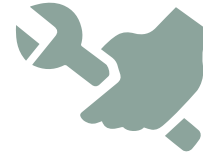

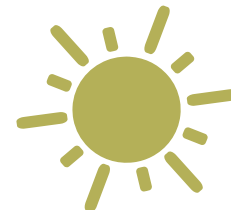
