January 30, 2025

Following a plea of guilty to two counts of Aggravated Murder for the premeditated and purposeful murders of Linda Fink and Robert Adams on November 25, 2024, Charles Fink was sentenced today to Life Without the Possibility of Parole for each count of Aggravated Murder.

The case was investigated by Morrow County Detectives Rob Chalfant and James Coulter.

The State's was represented at plea and sentencing by Morrow County Prosecuting Attorney Andrew Wick. Representing the Crime Victim Services Office are Director Richelle Ettel and Assistant Director Ashley Sinden. The Defendant was represented by Kirk McVay and Earl K. Desmond.

Presiding over the case was Common Pleas Judge Robert Hickson Jr.
