Count One: Involuntary Manslaughter

The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of Richland County, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present:

Kiarral Brock, on or about the 26th day of June, 2025, at the county of Richland aforesaid, did cause the death of [REDACTED] and such death was the proximate result of Kiarral Brock committing or attempting to commit the felony offense of Endangering Children, R.C. Section 2919.22(A), a felony of the third degree in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2903.04(A), 2903.04(C), **Involuntary Manslaughter**, a felony of the first degree.

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Two: Endangering Children

The Grand Jurors do further find and present:

Kiarral Brock, on or about the 26th day of June, 2025, at the county of Richland aforesaid, was a parent, guardian, custodian, person having custody or control, or person in loco parentis of a child under eighteen years of age, who did create a substantial risk to the health or safety of [REDACTED] by violating a duty of care, protection, or support in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2919.22(A), 2919.22(E)(2)(c), **Endangering Children**, a felony of the third degree.

FURTHERMORE, the violation resulted in serious physical harm to K.B..

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Three: Reckless Homicide

The Grand Jurors do further find and present:

Kiarral Brock, on or about the 26th day of June, 2025, at the county of Richland aforesaid, did recklessly cause the death of [REDACTED] in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2903.041(A), 2903.041(B), **Reckless Homicide**, a felony of the third degree.

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.




