Appointing a new member to the Richland County 9-1-1 Review Committee pursuant to ORC Section 128.06, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 128 has been updated by the Ohio Legislature and took effect October 3, 2023; and

WHEREAS, ORC Section 128.06, states every county shall maintain a county 9-1-1 program review committee, which shall serve without compensation and shall consist of six voting members as follows:

1. A member of the board of county commissioners, or a designee, who shall serve as chairperson on the committee;
2. The chief executive officer of the most populous municipal corporation in the county;
3. A member of the board of township trustees of the most populous township in the county as selected by majority vote of the board of trustees;
4. A member of a board of township trustees selected by the majority of boards of township trustees in the county pursuant to resolutions they adopt;
5. A member of the legislative authority of a municipal corporation in the county selected by the majority of the legislative authorities of municipal corporations in the county pursuant to resolutions they adopt;
6. An elected officer from within the county appointed by the board of county commissioners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby appoint the following individual as a voting member of the Richland County 9-1-1 Program Review Committee:
