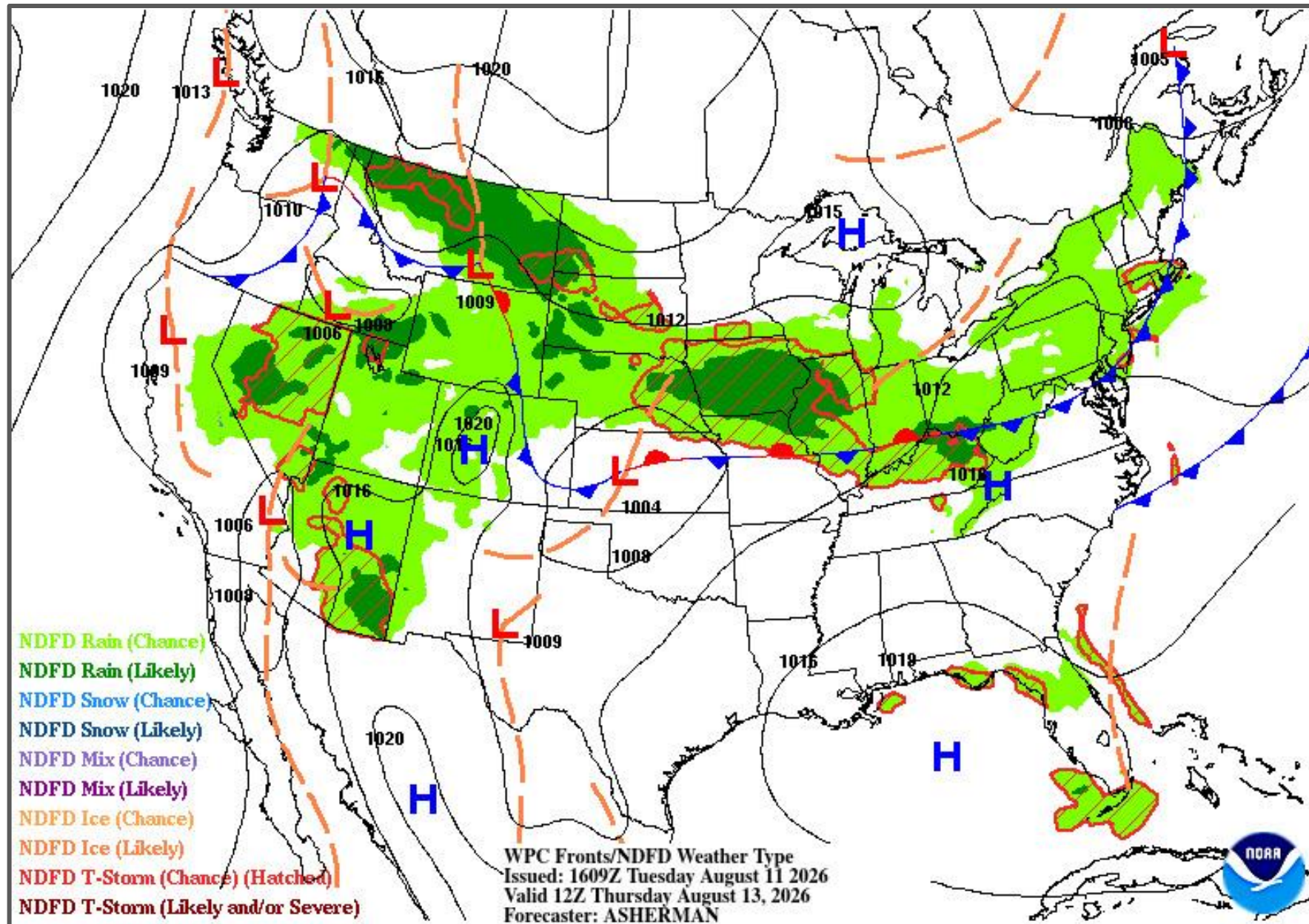
- Low pressure and a stationary front linger in the vicinity of the region on Wednesday.

- Highs in the low 80s.



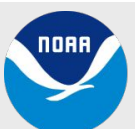


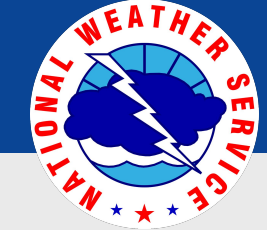

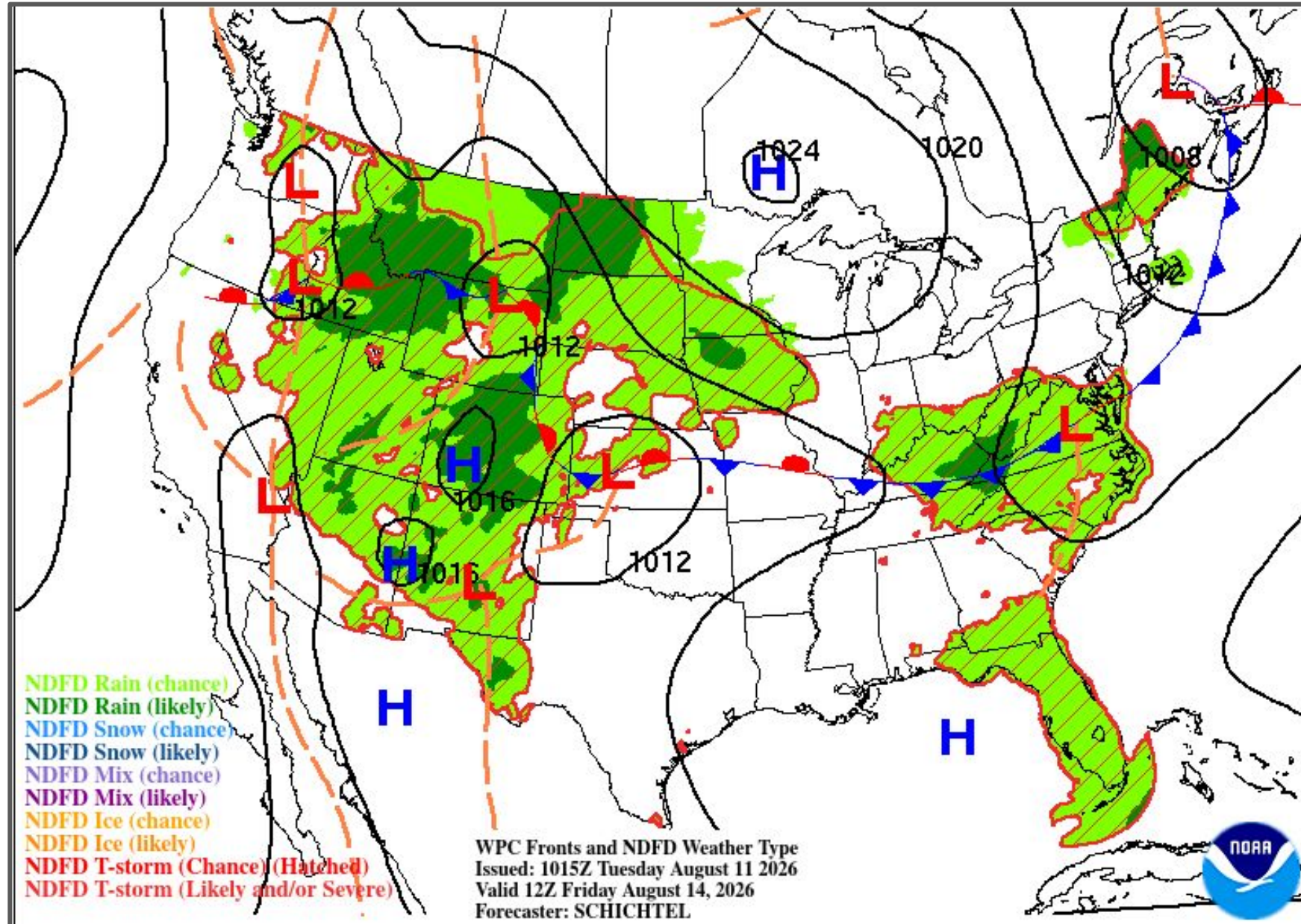
- Additional showers and thunderstorms will be possible on Thursday.
- Highs in the low 80s.



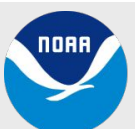


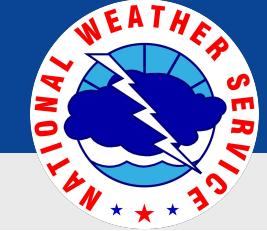

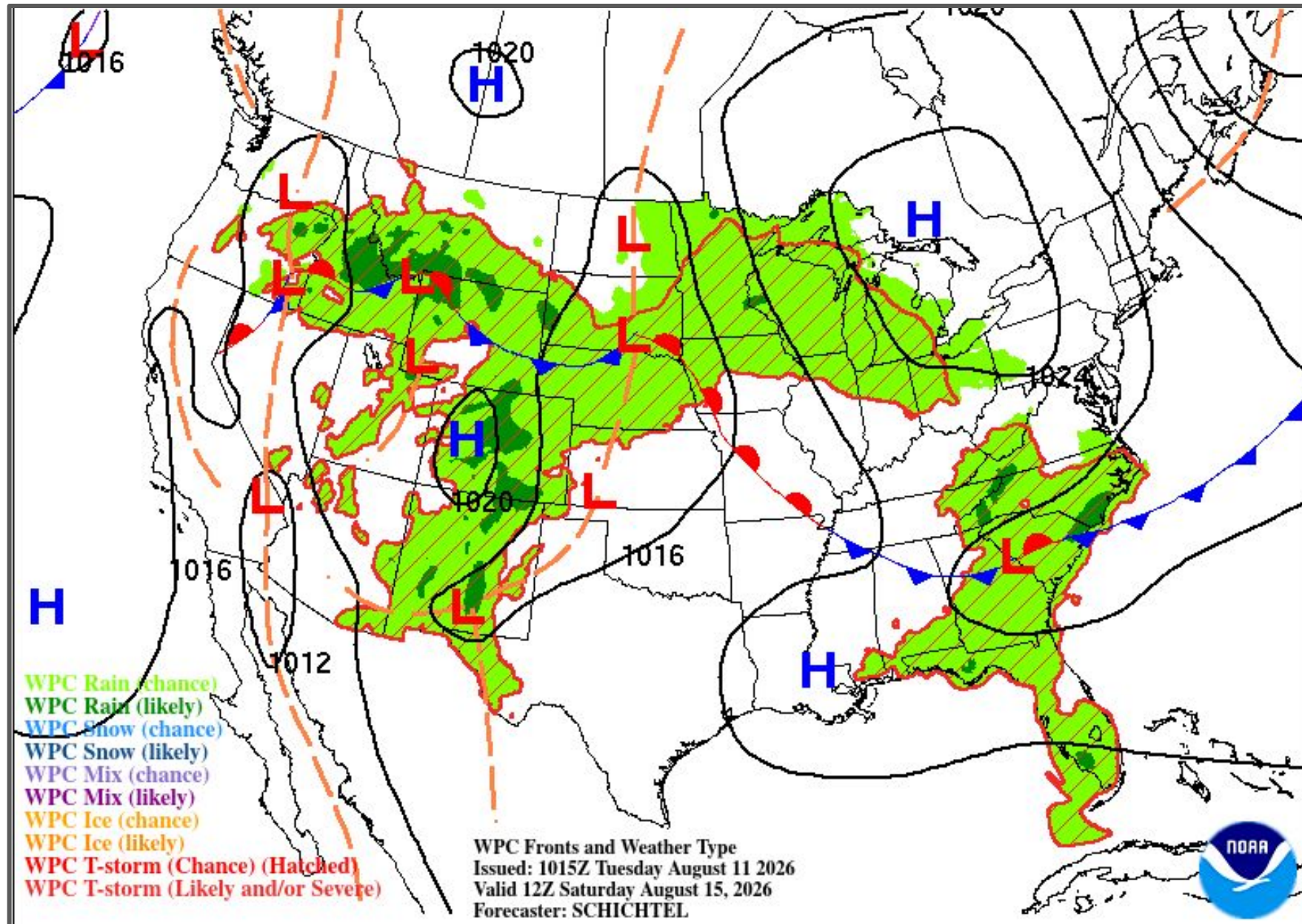
- Dry weather returns on Friday as high pressure enters from the northwest.

- Highs in the upper 70s/lower 80s.



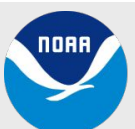


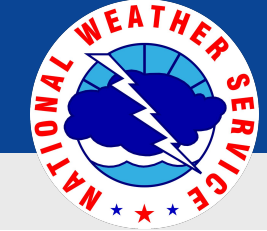

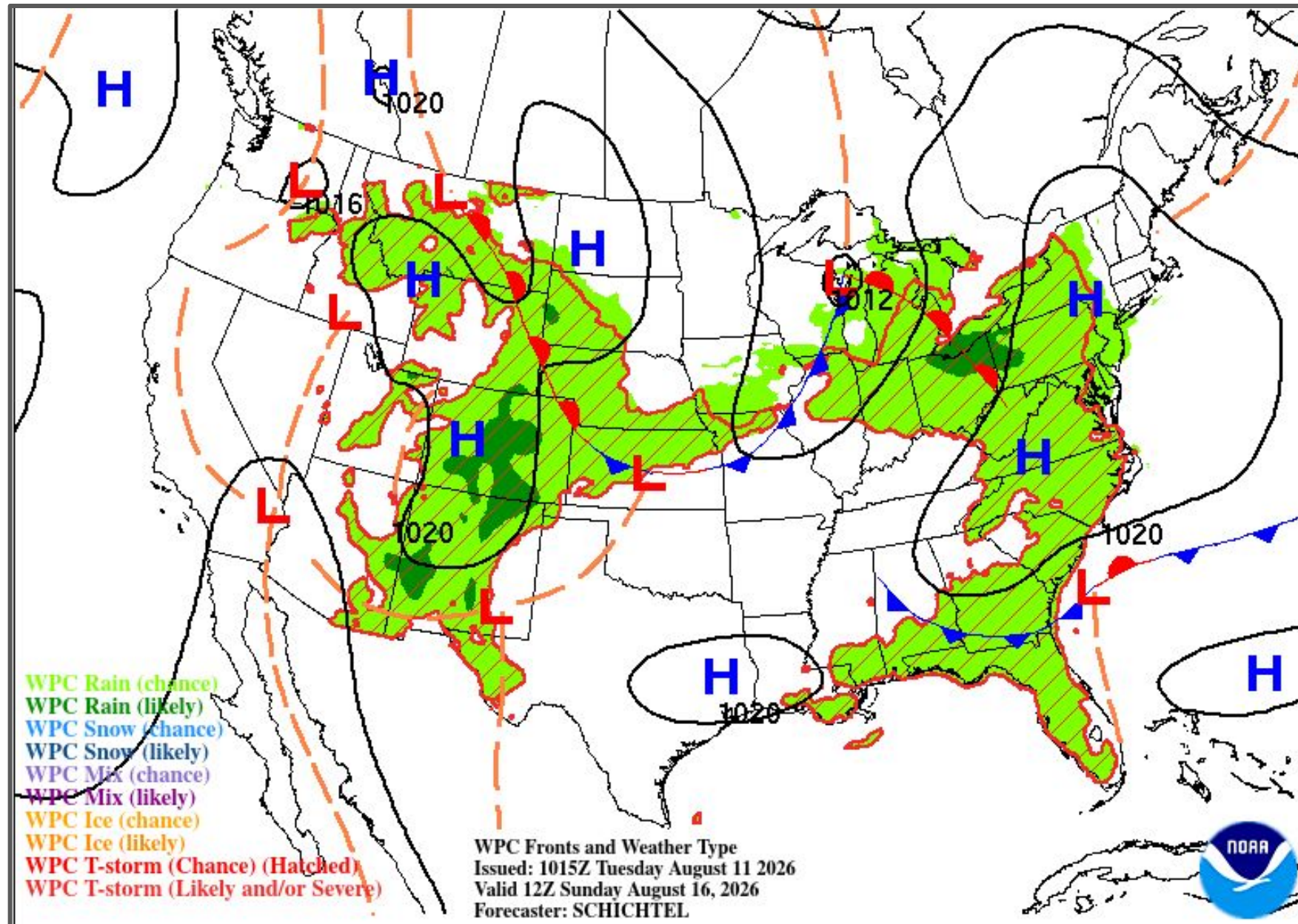
- Showers and storms will return Saturday afternoon/evening as the ridge of high pressure exits east.
- Highs in the upper 70s/lower 80s.



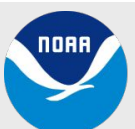


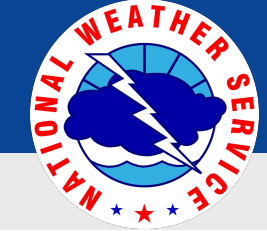

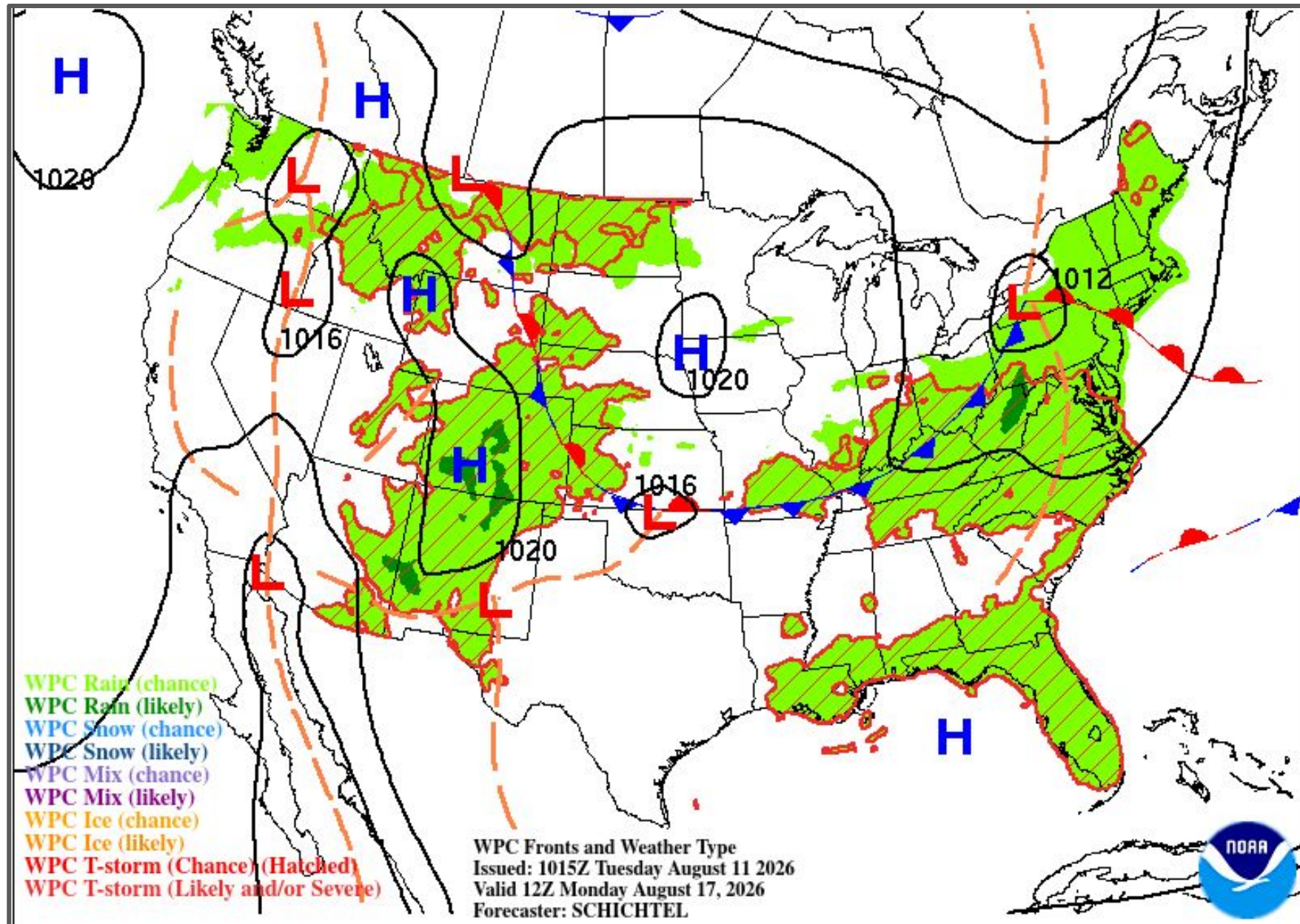
- Low pressure lifts a warm front across the region on Sunday.

- Highs in the mid 80s.



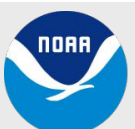


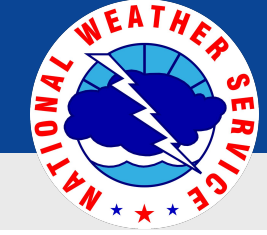

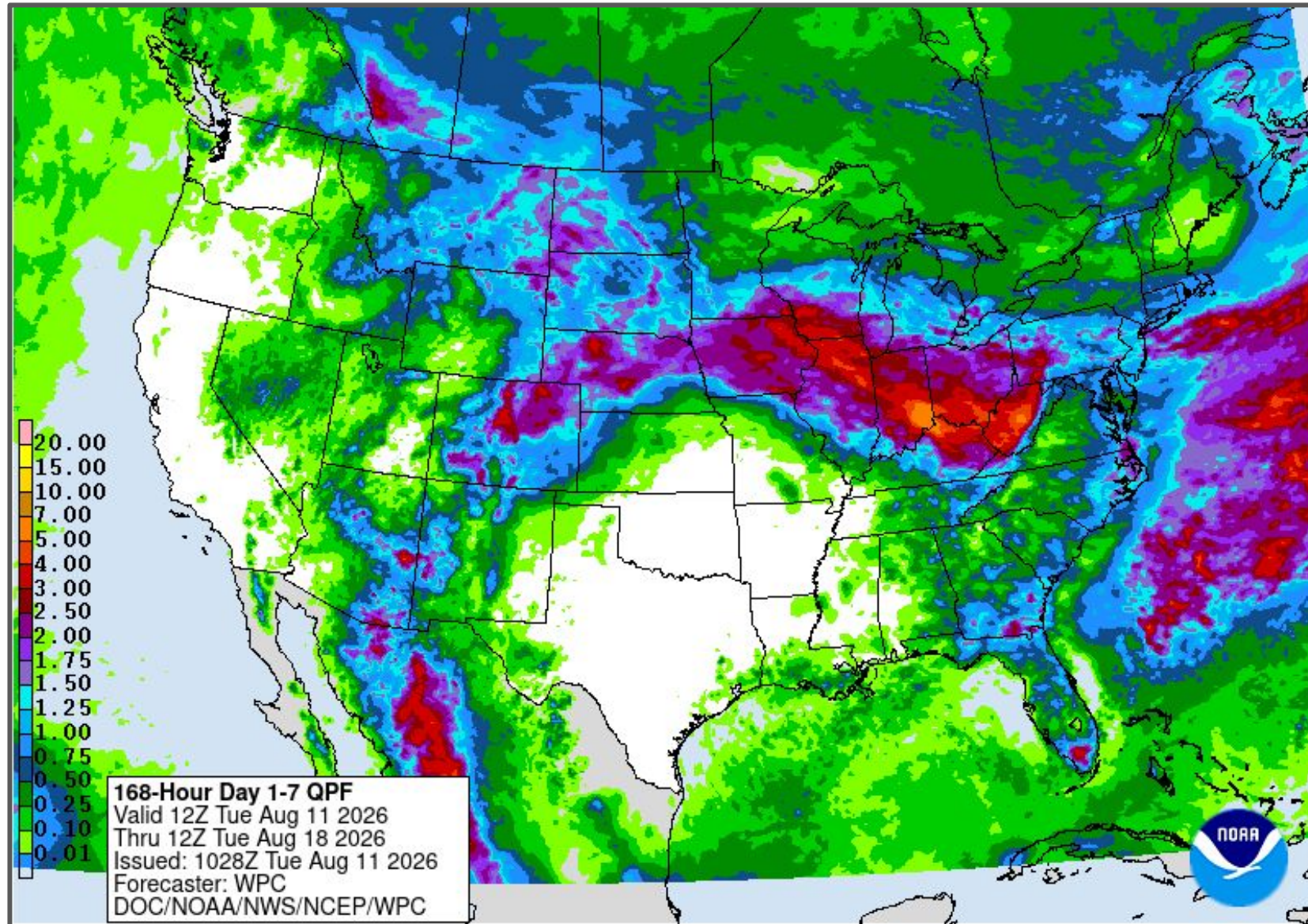
- Low will drag a cold front eastward on Monday.

- Highs in the upper 70s/lower 80s.



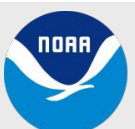


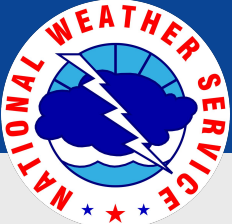
Day 1-7 Precipitation Forecast

- New rainfall amounts through next Monday: 1.5-2.5", locally higher amounts of 2.5-3" along and south of US-30



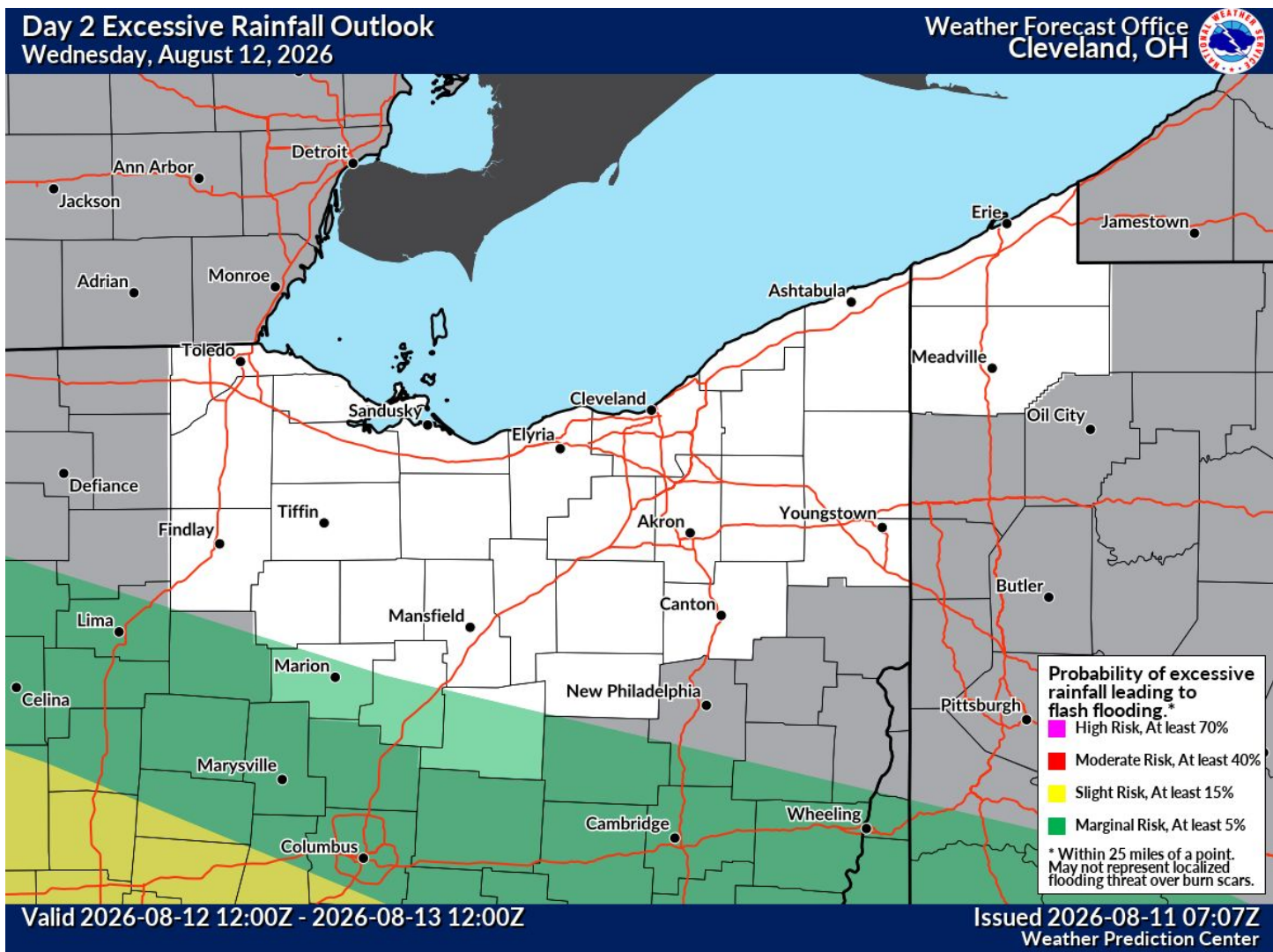
