Patrol Investigating Two Vehicle Fatal Crash in Morrow County

Mount Gilead – The Mount Gilead Post of the Ohio State Highway Patrol is investigating a fatal crash that occurred on September 4, 2026, at approximately 08:02 PM, in Westfield Township, Morrow County.

Tyler Weaver, age 30, of Cardington, was traveling southwest on US Route 42 on a 2000 Harley Davidson Electra Glide. William Stover, age 47, of Wheelersburg, was traveling eastbound on County Road 25 in a 2009 Chevrolet Malibu.

Mr. Stover failed to yield at the stop sign at the intersection of County Road 25 and US 42 and was struck by Mr. Weaver. A passenger on the Harley Davidson, who was identified as Amanda Pickens, age 38, of Ashley, was pronounced deceased at the scene by Morrow County EMS. Mr. Weaver was injured as a result of the crash and was transported to Morrow County Hospital. Mr. Stover was not injured in the crash. Neither occupant of the Harley Davidson was wearing a helmet at the time of the crash.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol was assisted at the scene by the Morrow County Sheriff's Office, Morrow County EMS, A'Rays Towing, the Morrow County Prosecutor's Office, and the Morrow County Coroner. The crash remains under investigation.

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
